



FILIPPO TESSARI – FEEM

Filippo Tessari is the Head of the Office of the Executive Director at FEEM. In this capacity he:

- (i) manages the coordination of internal processes and professionals involved in FEEM's operations, in order to ensure the proper implementation of Executive Management's guidelines;
- (ii) fosters the joint collaboration among staff members and other professionals, ensuring the monitoring and achievement of fixed KPIs;
- (iii) supports the Executive Management in the definition of multiannual plans and in the scouting and identification of strategic projects;
- (iv) maintains relations with FEEM Scientific Advisory Board.

For all the above-mentioned tasks, he directly reports to the Executive Director.

Moreover, he manages the operations for the Eni Award project, and is responsible for FEEM's consultancy activities in Africa. Between 2018 and 2021 he was Research Operative Coordination, Networking and Integration Manager at FEEM, overseeing the operative coordination of research activities, the managerial guidelines' follow-up, the information and competency interactions between FEEM's Research Programmes, as well as for the networking operations, alongside the Scientific Coordinators of the Programmes.

Graduated in Philosophy with a thesis on Economic Anthropology achieved after a field research in Nepal, Filippo worked both in online and traditional publishing before joining FEEM in 2006 as economic and cultural anthropology researcher.
