

BEING AWARE OF SANCTIONS IN CASE OF FALSE STATEMENTS HEREBY DECLARES:

- o I am aware of the measures put into place in Italy to contain the spread of the COVID-19 virus and I commit to adopting all the necessary prevention measures, in compliance with all the applicable laws in force and also with recommendations and instructions issued by both the WHO and the national health authority, aimed at preventing the spread of COVID-19:
- o For European Union citizens: I have a valid "EU digital covid certificate";
- o For people from outside the EU: I have a Negative PCR test result for SARS-CoV-2 that is not older than 72 hours or Negative rapid antigen test result that is not older than 48 hours. All tests taken and used as supporting evidence of a negative result must be recognized by European Union.
- o In the last 14 days I have not been in contact (or I am not aware of it) with individuals tested positive for COVID-19 nor have I received any communications from authorities in charge, as to a personal close contact I might have had with a person infected with novel Coronavirus COVID-19:
- I do not come from risk areas according to the WHO and the national health authority provisions.
- I am responsible to immediate report the appearance of any of the above symptoms that may occur in the 8 days after attending OMC 2021 and guarantees
- o I am currently not subject to health surveillance nor to fiduciary isolation;
- I do not have flu symptoms, fever or cough, decrease or loss of smell/taste nor respiratory difficulties:
- I am aware that, before accessing OMC 2021 Venue, I might undergo a body temperature check and that, should my temperature exceed 37.5°. I will not be allowed access
- the masks worn inside OMC 2021 venue are surgical mask or FFP2 replaced every 8 hours

Personal data processing policy

In accordance with the UE Regulation n. 679/2016 (so-said GDPR), we hereby provide the information as to personal data processing for individuals that, during the emergency of the COVID-19, so-said Coronavirus, shall access premises and offices of OMC 2021

Types of personal data processed and of individuals involved

Within the limits, for the purposes and with the methods indicated in this policy, the following data will be processed:

- a) data concerning body temperature;
- b) information as to close contacts at high exposure risk, within the previous 14 days, with individuals either suspect or tested positive for COVID-19;
- c) information as to the presence, within the previous 14 days, in risk areas according to the WHO provisions.

Data processing purposes and legal basis

Personal data will be exclusively processed for the prevention of COVID-19 spread, in compliance with the safety protocol adopted under art. 1. n. 7. letter d) of DPCM dated 11th March 2020.

Therefore, the data processing legal basis is to be found in the implementation of the safety protocol under art. 1, n. 7, letter d) of DPCM dated 11th March 2020.

Nature of personal data provision

Providing persona data is a necessary condition for accessing OMC 2021 venue. Refusing to provide them will prevent access.

Processing methods, scope and duration

With reference to body temperature measuring, OMC SCRL will not record the datum. The identification of the person involved and the recording of the temperature exceeding the established threshold might take place only should it be necessary to document the reasons for preventing access. In this case, the person involved will be duly

Personal data will neither be transmitted nor communicated to third parties unless in compliance with provisions in force (e.g. should the Health Authority require them in order to re-construct the sequence of all possible close contacts of a participant traced positive for COVID-19).

The Data Controller will retain the personal data collected for a period of 14 days, estimated necessary for the achievement of the purposes for which they are collected and processed, which is preventing COVID-19 spread.

Rights of individuals involved

At any time, individuals involved have the right to access their personal data, and to ask the relevant correction, updating and cancellation. It is also possible to object to personal data processing and to request a processing

Moreover, should a person deem that processing has been carried out in violation of the regulation on personal data protection, he/she may file a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Authority, Piazza Venezia, 11 - 00187 -Roma.
